Footnotes

BEVYS BEST was able to move clear and dictate the pace racing about the three path while on a short lead, shook off a challenge from OKIE DOZER entering the far turn to kick clear into the lane again then was shaken up a bit midstretch to hold the margin. OKIE DOZER stalked the pace from three wide to late backstretch, moved inside entering the far turn to nearly reach the winner's flank but could not match strides while finishing well to gain clear for the place. FIRST CLASS BRASS settled back off the early pace, moved two and three wide through traffic to have aim entering the stretch but could not produce the needed late run. PAGER rallied to contention while three and four wide through the far turn but lacked the needed late response. BLUMIN ATTITUDE trailed to the far turn while out from the rail, angled out to move five wide into the stretch and gained position but could not threaten. DYNAMIC AFFAIR stalked the early pace while three or four wide and weakened. HESO saved ground and failed to threaten. BLAKE RATTLENROLL was a close up pace factor racing three and four wide, continued in reach to the far turn then drifted through that bend and gave way into the lane. PENNY PACKER was just off the early pace from inside the winner and tired.
