Footnotes

THEE HEMI moved to a clear lead racing out from the rail, drew off through the far turn then was kept to steady urging in the lane while holding clear. BLUMIN WON stalked the leaders from three wide, made a mild gain on the winner but could not threaten late while clear of the others. POWER SWEEP LEFT tracked the leaders from four wide and had no closing run. BLUMMIN BEVY moved up three wide but could not threaten late. SPOOKY THUNDER lacked a bid racing three wide. MITT saved ground, lacked a closing bid then had his rider lose whip turning into the lane. SAMMY WILL TELL lunged at the break then was four and five wide through the first turn and weakened. CLAIM THE THRONE saved ground and weakened. SKWHIRL was always back. CLUEMASTER was four wide while near the back, angled in going to the far turn and never threatened.
