MERRY MARINO stalked the pace, raced four wide in the stretch and drew clear in the final stages under strong pressure. B B QUEEN OF SCAT pressed the pace from the inside, lacked room nearing the eighth pole and finished willingly in the final stages while racing along the inside. WHISKEY TEARS pressed the pace while racing between rivals and finished willingly to the wire. HIGH SPEED JUSTICE showed good speed from the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. MY HOMETOWN GAL was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. BEADED saved ground and never was a factor. CUVEE BLANC stalked the pace from the outside and tired. CLASSIC TEN showed little. TATUM GIRL failed to menace. DEPUTY'S WHIRL trailed throughout.
