Footnotes

LUCKY OZ stalked the pace from three wide to make his bid going to the far turn, put away BOZO in that bend and then held safe late under steady handling. DOC CASEY saved ground to the far turn while never far back, angled four wide midway of that bend and rallied to be getting to the winner late. BOZO made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail while inside JUKE JOINT JOHNNY, continued with the winner to late in the far turn and had little left. GRAMMAS BOY stalked the leaders racing two to three wide and weakened. GOLDEN CEDAR was five wide through the first turn, remained outside while stalking the pace and tired. SNEAKIE PETESKI was always back. JUKE JOINT JOHNNY prompted the pace from outside BOZO for a half mile and tired.
