FOUR PAWS settled off the dueling early leaders racing three wide, rallied in the far turn then reeled in WYALAYA through the lane to prevail in the closing yards. WYALAYA dueled from outside MS. BUMPER for the early lead, kicked clear going to the far turn and brought a sizeable lead to the lane then could not keep the winner safe late. ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE rallied four wide to reach contention through the far turn then could not threaten the top pair late. MERRY MARINO saved ground and improved position while not a threat. MS. BUMPER contested the early lead inside WYALAYA and weakened through the far turn. SHE'S A GRAND DAY stalked the leaders racing three to four wide and tired. GRAND ON FANCY was not a factor racing three and four wide.
