Footnotes

VALID THIEF tucked in going to the first turn, moved up while angling between foes nearing the lane and wore down THREE RUDYS to be up late. THREE RUDYS made the pace on a short lead three or four wide and could not contain the winner late. FLAMING GLORY angled five wide out of the first turn, challenged into the far turn and could not sustain the rally. GIN HE KIN HE moved up five wide. MINIMAL RISK prompted the pace racing out from the rail to the far turn and weakened. MILEAGE was along the inside and took back off the leaders early in the first turn, angled four wide to stalk but had no bid. SAINTLY SON turned his head to outside across the neighboring stall as the gate opened to become tangled and got away very slowly. MINER BIRD was not a threat. CAPTAIN CUGAT tired racing four to five wide.
