Footnotes

BLUMIN WON tracked the early leader racing out from the rail to challenge into the far turn, had his heels clipped as MITT challenged along the inside nearing the lane then moved off under steady handling. BENJAMIN E. stalked the leaders racing three and four wide to bid into the far turn then could not go with the winner in the lane. EWING TIGER rallied five wide into the lane and gained third while not a threat to the top pair. MITT stalked the pace from along the inside, bid along the rail inside the winner, checked then clipped that one's heels when trying to make a narrow opening and lost his chance. The rider of MITT lodged a claim of foul and the stewards posted an inquiry into the incident nearing the stretch with the results allowed to stand. SAMMY WILL TELL moved to a short lead in the opening quarter racing outside and weakened nearing the lane. HESO hesitated at the break, stalked the leaders from four wide and weakened. HIGH FLEET was taken to the outside into the first turn, angled back in going to the far turn and never threatened.
