Footnotes

SAX NOTES was caught wide into the turn, remained eight and nine wide through the bend into the lane and closed with a rush from midtrack to run down the leaders in the closing jumps. ANEJO showed speed from four wide but came in on rivals entering the turn to bump TOOL TRADE into CHIEF FAST CAT, moved clear into the lane and was caught late. Following a claim of foul by the rider of CHIEF FAST CAT, ANEJO was disqualified and placed seventh for causing interference entering the turn. BRAZOS EGO saved ground and avoided the trouble into the turn, continued along the rail into the lane and closed late. DR. SEVENCOMELEVEN vied from along the inside and was outfinished for position in the late going. TOOL TRADE was put in tight by the runnerup and checked, bumped with the horse inside of him entering the turn and could not rally back. MINING GOLD was five wide in the turn while near the leaders but lacked a final response. CHIEF FAST CAT was just off the rail when checked and bumped in the congestion entering the turn, shuffled back and never recovered. MFAZI was hung six to eight wide in the turn and never threatened. SMOOTH ALY was five wide in the turn and weakened. RICK'S WONDERBOY was always back while six and seven wide.
