LISIANSKI set all the pace from the outside and held gamely to be well clear under strong encouragement. ILIMITADO stalked the pace, moved up four wide a the eighth pole and finished second best. TATUM GIRL was allowed to settle early, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late rally. QUEEN ME stalked the pace, moved up four wide in the lane and had no final winning bid. SOBER AT LAST saved ground and had no response. MOOD WINNER showed little. MORE RUN broke awkwardly and remained back throughout. OH YOU SWEETEE was hustled along and tired. HOLYCHOIR failed to sustain a bid. RODELLA BOLERO was off slowly and never was a factor.
