Footnotes

LADY PLEASE made the pace on a contested lead racing about the three path and held well through the lane to keep DIALECT safe late under steady handling. DIALECT followed the pace racing out from the rail, angled outside the leaders for the drive and closed to be slowly getting to the winner. MIDWEST CONQUEST forced the issue from inside the winner through the turn then was outfinished for position late. GIVENITALLSHESCOTT dropped to near the back of the field going to the turn then made a belated rally from four wide into the lane. CRAFTY WAGER was just off the early leaders racing four wide and weakened nearing the lane. MISS HICKORY bobbled at the start then lost ground while five and six wide in the turn. WHENTHEDUSTSETTLES followed the pace from three wide and weakened. MISS G. I. weakened racing out from the rail. FROSTY DEBUT was outrun racing three to four wide. SILVER SIMMER was shuffled back in tight quarters after the break and always back while wide.
