C O BARQUEEN was five wide in the first turn while just off the leaders, settled four wide in good position to follow the pace, angled inside the leader entering the lane and wore that one down then just lasted late as LITTLE WIDOW MAKER closed strongly. LITTLE WIDOW MAKER was five wide in the first turn just off the leaders, moved up going to the far turn to rally four wide into the lane then closed well late to narrowly miss. GIVE ME FIVE prompted the pace from outside ZAZAMORA to bid and quickly move clear into the far turn, brought a good lead into the lane while remaining about the four path then could not contain the top pair late. TRUCKEE DOWN stalked the pace racing four wide and lacked a final closing response. WITT'SANNOUNCEMENT was not a threat racing three to four wide. JULIE C stumbled to her nose at the break, recovered to save ground in reach of the pace but failed to threaten. CAROL'S FRIEND moved up four wide while not a threat. ZAZAMORA was bumped at the break, moved clear racing about the three path in the first turn and tired readily through the lane. STEPHENETTE was bumped and squeezed back between rivals at the break then failed to threaten while three wide. ZIVA D. broke inward to bump with rivals then tired racing three to four wide.
