WRIGHT TRIBUTE pressed the pace and held gamely in the lane to prevail under steady pressure. LEES DYNA MAN stalked the pace from the outside, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and gained ground gamely in the final stages to just miss. VALID THIEF was unhurried early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and finished willingly to the wire. ROOT RIVER KID was off a step slow, raced four deep and made a mild late gain. WILD SKATER vied for the lead and tired. JACOB'S TIGER showed little. LORD OF TRICKS was bumped at the start, raced three deep and never menaced. STEP N'FETCH failed to sustain a bid. SAMMY WILL TELL showed brief foot from the inside and faded.
