Footnotes

COYANOSA settled back off the pace for the opening half mile, reeled in the leader going to the far turn, kicked clear through that bend then held EWING TIGER safe in the lane under steady handling. EWING TIGER stalked the leaders racing three to four wide, rallied in the lane but could not reach the winner. MAGNIFICENT BLUFF hesitated at the break to come away slowly, moved up four wide going to the far turn then made only a mild gain in the stretch. MORTRUMP hesitated at the break, moved inside heading up the backstretch then awaited room late in the far turn while slipping inside a tiring rival and could not close through the lane. HIGH FLEET lacked a bid racing four to five wide. BLUMIN ATTITUDE trailed the field to upper stretch, swung out in the lane and moved up while not a threat. THE STRAW MAN was not a threat racing four wide. RUN ZOOHA RUN was bumped at the start and lacked a rally racing four wide. KING TYMATT broke inward to bump with a rival, sprinted clear racing about the three path and tired.
