WINTER SUMMIT stalked the pace from the outside, moved up six wide nearing the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. DAKOTA METT was bumped at the start, raced towards the inside throughout and finished second best. SWEET TIGGER stalked the pace, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and was no real threat. MOON ON OVER was bumped hard at the start, raced three deep and never was a serious threat. GOATFEATHERS was bumped hard at the start, recovered quickly to press the early pace and gave way the final quarter of a mile. GIN HE KIN HE saved ground and never was a factor. BELOIT KAN TOO was bumped at the start, rushed to the early lead and tired readily.
