NOT SO SLOW contested the pace from outside THETOTALPACKAGE early to move clear heading up the backstretch then held the margin through the final quarter mile under steady handling. MITT moved up five wide into the far turn with his bid to have aim at the winner nearing the stretch but could not produce the needed final effort. SWEET BOY rallied six wide into the stretch and continued to gain late while unable to run down the top pair. A CEE bobbed at the break, stalked the tightly packed lead group from outside then weakened from five wide into the stretch. RYAN'S WAY was just off the leaders racing five wide, bid into the far turn and tired. NOT SO IRISH was shuffled back between rivals at the start, dropped back while three wide in the first turn the moved up in the lane while not a threat. THETOTALPACKAGE pressed the early pace from inside the winner and tired. PAWNEE RAIDER was in traffic through the first turn while in the closely bunched lead group and tired. SPORTS MANIAC saved ground and was not a factor. BLUMIN STAR broke out sharply at the start, was just off the leaders racing three wide and tired.
