NOBLE BANDIT dueled through a solid pace from outside DAY TRIPPI from the start, continued on strongly in the lane and edged away in the final sixteenth under steady handling. DAY TRIPPI dueled from inside the winner throughout and could not match strides through the closing sixteenth of a mile. STROLL BY stalked the dueling leaders while saving ground, angled out to move four wide into the lane and could not reach the top pair. BROOK GHAZER stalked the leaders racing out from the rail and failed to mount a bid. SAGE'S DREAM tracked the dueling leaders from four wide through the opening quarter mile then could not keep pace. DEPUTY'S WHIRL saved ground and was not a factor. FANCY PRINCESS followed the pace racing three to four wide and tired.
