Footnotes

FLOODGATE was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. KING OF RHYTHM was unhurried early, raced six deep in the stretch and made a good late bid. NAME THAT SONG pressed the pace, raced between rivals in the stretch and weakened a bit the final sixteenth of a mile. STARSOVERPARADISE stalked the pace, raced five wide in the lane and had no late winning bid. MAN FROM LORADO stalked the pace and tired. MYSTERIOUS MERLIN raced seven deep in the stretch and never was a factor. FUTURE FUN saved ground and never threatened. TOIN AND BOIN was bumped at the start, lacked racing room briefly at the eighth pole and never was a serious threat. CATTLE BARON was hustled from the inside and tired. TRIPLE X. raced far back and never threatened.
