Footnotes

THE NUTZ was on the pace from outside LARRYLARRYLARRY while under a comfortable hold, easily shook off the challenge of FIRST CLASS BRASS in the far turn to take command nearing the lane, drew off then was taken in hand and gearing down through the final sixteenth to win as much best. TIGER LAKE stalked the pace from the outside, was in good position but steadied from tight quarters as rivals closed a hole going to the far turn, checked and altered course to the inside later in that bend then closed through the lane to clearly gain his position while not a match for the winner. FIRST CLASS BRASS stalked the leaders racing out from the rail to move to the winner into the far turn and reach near even terms but could not sustain the effort. FIRE UP THE BELL was just off the leaders racing three to four wide, bid nearing the far turn and also could not sustain the move. LARRYLARRYLARRY prompted the pace from outside the winner to late backstretch and tired. HOT WIRED moved up three and four wide through the far turn but lacked a convincing bid. SKWHIRL stalked the leaders from outside and tired. ENTOURAGE tired after stalking the pace from outside. BLACKHAWK'S GOLD was always back. MR. PINSTRIPE raced wide and tired.
