QUEEN ALEX settled along the inside to prompt the pace of GUMP'S SILHOUETTE to late backstretch, moved to challenge and move clear through the far turn then widened under steady urging. GOIN' TO RENO stalked the pace while racing four to five wide on the turn and could not go with the winner through the final quarter. MISS TWO BAGGER was never far back racing along the inside to challenge turning for home but could only hold her position in the lane. A ROYAL SUMMER threw her head at the start while coming away slowly, tracked the pace while behind rivals and lacked the needed response in the lane. GUMP'S SILHOUETTE made the early pace out from the rail and had nothing left in the late going. NEVERS TRUMP CARD saved ground to no avail. NASTY POCKET stalked the pace three wide throughout, steadied when in a bit tight between rivals going into the far turn and tired.
