TIGER LAKE settled back off the early pace racing outside, moved four wide on the far turn to rally determinedly into the lane and wore down POWER SWEEP LEFT in the closing yards. POWER SWEEP LEFT showed the most speed to gain the inside going to the first turn, shook off a challenge into the far turn to edge clear again then could not hold the winner safe late. STEELER tracked the pace from outside the place horse, bid into the far turn but could not match strides and weakened in the lane. I'M ON A QUEST stalked the pace in good position from outside but failed to produce a bid. MUSICAL SMOKE saved ground and failed to threaten. WINDY RUSH saved ground to the far turn, angled out to move six wide into the lane and could not threaten. SHAWKLIT FANTASY steadied a bit going to the first turn as the winner moved to the winner, chased the pace racing out from the rail and weakened. THE RUZZ saved ground and failed to produce a bid. BOW RIVER trailed throughout.
