ELUSIVE PLEASURE dropped back off the pace racing outside, rallied in the far turn to angle six wide into the lane, came out from a lefthanded stick but closed strongly from midtrack to be up at the wire. THE NUTZ stalked the leaders racing two to three wide, bid into the lane and quickly drew clear in upper stretch then just failed to hold the winner safe. JUST HANK was just off the early leaders along the inside, angled out heading up the backstretch to bid four wide through the far turn then could not sustain the run in the drive. FROM THE ASHES showed speed from five wide in the first turn to draw clear heading up the backstretch, continued to late in the far turn and came up empty in the drive. PLANTOBEREADY stalked the leaders from four wide, moved clear into the far turn but weakened while six wide into the lane. THATS RAY'S TIGER saved ground in good position but weakened. ALERT THE PRESS prompted the pace racing three to four wide to the far turn and weakened. SCHOOL'S OUT contested the early lead between rivals and tired. ABEL WINAPRIZE was not a threat. A FAIR AFFAIR was always back while wide.
