TENTH POWER settled back off the pace set by his stablemate while racing three wide, rallied to challenge SONG OF HUMOR through the far turn while about the four path, took command into the lane then was roused briefly and moved off. THE NUTZ bumped after the break between rivals and jostled to the back of the field, moved up four and five wide in the second turn to take aim at the entymates heading up the backstretch then rallied clear for the place. SONG OF HUMOR soon moved to the front while under a hard hold, made the running to the final turn and came up empty in the drive. NO IT AIN'T bumped with a rival after the start, saved ground for a half mile, angled three wide heading up the backstretch and moved up but could not threaten. SPOKEN IN TONES was not a threat racing four wide. HEZA WILD GUY saved ground in reach of the leaders to midway up the backstretch and tired. TRICKYEXPECTATIONS saved ground through the opening half mile, angled out in the second turn and tired. REGAL INDIAN came in to bump with THE NUTZ after the break, chased the leaders from three wide and tired.
