GRAND ON AFFAIR showed good speed from the inside and finished gamely to be clear under strong encouragement. MACHUPECHI pressed the pace, raced three deep in the lane and finished gamely to be second best. MORRIS BORIS stalked the pace, saved ground and finished willingly to the wire. TALENTED PLAYER stalked the pace while racing between horses and had no final winning bid. GOTCHER NUMBER was bumped at the start, raced five wide and never was a factor. EXPLICIT CREEK was bumped at the start, stalked the pace and tired. RIVER ROMANCE was shuffled back at the start and remained back throughout. MITT was fanned seven wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. THREE RUDYS was bumped at the start, hustled from the outside and tired in the lane.
