WHATA SMUCK stalked the pace, moved up three wide down the backstretch to gain command, Matt N Mitch loomed boldly through the far turn but couldn't match strides in the lane as Whata Smuck edged clear in the final stages under strong pressure. MATT N MITCH was unhurried early, moved up four wide and finished second best. WINTER SUMMIT stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and had no final winning bid. PROCERITY was unhurried early, raced four wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. GONE TO AUSTIN was bumped at the start, raced six deep at the eighth pole and never was a serious threat. DIGITRY failed to sustain a bid. DOCTOR CLICK was bumped at the start, raced four wide and never menaced. MAKING DREAMS set all the pace from the outside and gave way. FOREVER MOON was bumped at the start and never was in contention. CHARLIE'S REPRIZED pressed the pace and tired.
