Footnotes

CLASSIC MAURA stalked the pace racing three and four wide, moved to the five path entering the lane to rally clear then held safe late as CO SASSY made her late run. CO SASSY saved ground while well back early, angled out nearing the far turn to rally four wide and closed well through the lane but could not run down the winner. TRINACRIA was five and six wide in the first turn while in reach of the pace, angled in going to the far turn to rally up the inside in the lane but could not reach the top pair. CHOCOLATE DIVA moved to the front racing in the three or four path through the first turn, remained out in the track to bring a short lead into the lane and weakened some late. OVID FASTI stalked the pace from four wide, angled six wide nearing the lane but could not produce the needed late response. FAST CITY GIRL saved ground and lacked a closing response. SLEW'S BET drifted out in the first turn, remained in reach while outside then fanned seven wide into the lane and lost ground. SWEET VIOLET was not a factor racing four to five wide. QUITE A KITTY broke inward but was quickly corrected then failed to threaten while three wide. MEXICAN TIME showed early speed racing out from the rail and gave way in the far turn.
