Footnotes

SAINTLY SON stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under strong pressure. FORTY BELOW was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished second best. PECKINPAH showed good early speed along the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. C. O. AL was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. FRED HENRY pressed the pace from the outside and faltered in the drive. TOAST IN THE PARK dropped back early, raced three wide and never was a factor. SMOAKBOX saved ground and never threatened. END ZONE was outrun. TOP OF THE HERD showed little. SILVER WILDCAT was hustled along and tired.
