TENSASTRIKE stalked the pace, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to edge clear in the final stages under steady handling. SHAWZINATOR set all the pace from the outside but couldn't hold off the winner in the final stages. REGAL INDIAN was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch never was a serious threat for the top two. WAYNE A BLUE stalked the pace from the outside and weakened in the drive. CUVEE'S CLEVER pressed the pace and gave way. WILSONS STORM was unhurried early, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. TIGERSTARK raced towards the inside and never threatened. PAJAMIANO saved ground and never menaced. BARON SLEW broke awkwardly and was always back. THE QUINNSTER saved ground and never threatened.
