BELOIT KAN TOO made the pace on a short lead from along the inside, shook off his nearest challenger and edged away under steady urging. CHEATIN COWBOY tracked the winner from three or four wide and could not match strides in the lane. HORIZON POINT stalked the leaders from four wide and lacked a closing response. MARSHALL DILLION settled in good position off the leaders racing three wide and lacked a rally. BROKEN CONNECTION was squeezed back then checked at the start from between rivals, dropped back while saving ground and moved up in the drive. B G TOP YANKEE settled back off the pace racing three wide, ran up heels between rivals and steadied approaching the far turn then continued to improve position in the lane. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR moved up three and four wide while not a threat. BRAZOS EGO saved ground in reach of the pace and weakened. JAYEMBRO came out at the break to put a rival in tight then weakened racing three wide. GRAND ON AFFAIR followed the pace from four wide and tired.
