BUFFALO CREEK HAWK broke into the side of the gate then bumped with a rival, contested the pace from along the inside to edge clear nearing the lane and held the margin under steady handling. PACIFIC TSUNAMI bumped with the winner at the start, saved ground in reach of the leaders, angled four wide nearing the lane and rallied but could not threaten the winner late. SWEET TIGGER forced the pace outside rivals to the far turn, could not go with the winner late then lost the place in the closing jump. HEY RED stalked the pace in good position from four wide and weakened. HOLIDAY BUZZ lacked a rally racing four and five wide. SMOKIN' LEGEND dropped back off the leaders racing four and five wide, angled in going to the far turn but had no rally. AMAZING BUD contested the pace from between rivals to the far turn and weakened. FIVE ALARM stumbled badly causing his rider to lose irons at the start, dropped well back as the rider regained his irons through the opening furlong and a half then continued to close the gap. END ZONE stalked the leaders from three wide and tired.
