Footnotes

CACTUS MAX saved ground just off the leaders, came through inside to bid through midstretch and edged clear under steady handling. BURN CARD made the running from inside R R GOLD while out from the rail then could not handle the winner while holding clear for the place. R R GOLD forced the pace from outside BURN CARD into the lane and weakened a bit late. YOUTHFUL AMBITION made a mild rally four wide into the lane but could not threaten late. SHOOT THE RAPIDS moved up while six wide in the turn. KING RED was five wide into the turn, traded bumps with NORTHERN TWIST through most of the turn and could not threaten. NORTHERN TWIST was angled out going to the turn, traded bumps with KING RED for a sixteenth of a mile and lacked a rally. FAITHFUL SECRET saved ground and weakened. GENERAL LAFAYETTE was not a factor while wide in the turn. BELOIT KAN TOO saved ground and was outrun.
