B B QUEEN OF SCAT settled off the pace racing three wide, angled out to rally five wide through the far turn, reached the front into the lane and edged clear under steady urging. MERRY MARINO lunged at the break, stalked the leaders from along the inside, bid going to the far turn then could not go with the winner late. SAFE N RICH bumped with a rival at the start, followed the pace four and five wide but lacked a final closing response. LOVESAVICTORY tracked the leaders from three wide to late backstretch, angled in going to the far turn but lacked a rally. RARE CRYSTAL tracked the early pace while five wide, challenged midway up the backstretch but weakened through the far turn. DON'T TELL DAD bumped with a rival at the start and failed to threaten racing four wide. LYNAE DAWN saved ground and was not a factor. DEVILS KISS trailed throughout. C O PEACE made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail to the far turn and gave way.
