DEVILS BATTLE made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail, shook off a bid from QUICK KETCHUP in the far turn to move clear again then drew off under steady urging. QUICK KETCHUP stalked the pace outside to bid four wide into the far turn, went with the winner to nearing the lane then could not match strides while clearly best of the others. SENATOR BERI stalked the pace racing three to four wide and weakened nearing the lane. SLEW Z COWBOY settled back off the pace racing three wide, angled in going to the far turn and moved up while not a threat. OAK VALLEY moved up four wide. SAM DIEGO chased the pace from inside the winner and tired. ZOOHA'S LAST BABY was not a factor racing four wide. HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY clipped the heels of a rival and had his rider lose his irons after the break then was always back. THUNDER N SMOKE followed the pace from three wide and tired.
