Footnotes

BEGG'S stalked the pace, gained command down the backstretch and held gamely in the drive to be clear under strong encouragement. SAX NOTES stalked the pace from the outside, moved up four wide to challenge and finished second best. CITY SLICKER was unhurried early, raced four wide in the stretch and made a mild late rally. MONEY TO BURN dropped back early, raced three deep and made a mild late gain. FAREWELL BROADWAY stalked the pace from the inside and tired. WATCH THE GAP settled off the early pace, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. MANDATE MAKER showed good speed from the inside and weakened while racing four deep in the lane. COUNTY CLERK failed to respond. MAGNIFICENT BLUFF was slow early and never menaced. SILVER WILDCAT pressed the pace and tired.
