SWEET TIGGER contested the pace from inside PRAY TO WIN while racing in the three to four path, angled to the five path entering the lane and drew well clear then held safe under a mild hand ride. JUST HANK stalked the pace racing four to five wide, angled eight wide into the lane and made a mild gain. DAKOTA METT was just off the leaders while fanned seven wide out of the first turn, continued from four and five wide to force the issue, could not go with the winner then came out late and bumped with a rival at the wire. GIN HE KIN HE followed the pace racing four wide, angled seven wide into the lane then came in a bit and bumped with a rival at the wire. STEVE'S BIG MOE saved ground racing out from the rail, angled out entering the lane then was bumped between rivals at the wire. LIL BUDDY saved ground and failed to mount a bid. PRAY TO WIN forced the early pace outside the winner and tired.
