**Footnotes**

BET YOUR BOOTS stalked the pace in good position while never far back, moved three and four wide through the far turn into the lane to show in front turning for home then slowly edged clear of NO HESITATION under steady urging. NO HESITATION was on the pace racing out from the rail while placed inside LOU LOU LARUE, edged clear into the far turn, resisted the winner as that one challenged nearing the lane then could not match strides late. BACH'S HOMEBREW saved ground while near the back early, remained inside to make a good bid to contention through the far turn and reach the leaders then could not sustain the run in the lane. LOU LOU LARUE forced the issue from outside NO HESITATION to the far turn and weakened through that bend. PROFESSOR POLLARD saved ground to the far turn, worked his way through traffic in that bend while three wide then could not threaten in the lane. C O RINGO stalked the leaders racing out from the rail and weakened. CAT RULER followed the pace racing three to four wide through the far turn and tired. AHBUDD bumped with a rival at the start and failed to produce a bid racing three wide. FIVE OCLOCK SHADOW tired racing three wide. DANNAGAN bumped with a rival at the start and failed to threaten.
