BAILOUT BILL dueled on the pace from outside MR. MCGAUNASH while racing about the five path, put that one away in upper stretch and drew off under steady handling. OUR TIGER was bumped and shuffled back at the start, settled four and five wide to stalk the pace then made a late bid to gain second. MR. MCGAUNASH dueled from inside the winner while racing about the three path, could not go with that one in the lane then lost the place late. C O STEPHEN stalked the pace in good position from along the inside and lacked a final closing response. DOS ANGELS WARRIOR moved up five wide in the far turn but could not threaten. NIX OF KIN lunged at the break, followed the pace racing four to five wide and weakened. CHATHAM BARS followed the pace from three wide and tired. KENDO tired racing along the inside. RUN ON BUY was bumped at the start and always back racing four wide. SHILOH VALLEY broke inward to bump with rivals and bobbed then was always back racing three wide.
