Footnotes

DISEMBARK was allowed to settle early, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and just got up under strong pressure. TONY FOREST stalked the pace, raced four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to the wire. TUFF COWBOY stalked the pace, raced five deep in the stretch and finished willingly to the wire. CAPETOWN CHARLES pressed the pace and finished willingly the drive. WINACRACKERJACK dropped back early, raced three deep and had no late winning bid. SELECTIVE TIME showed good speed from the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. PAPPY HALL raced in tight quarters soon after the start, saved ground and never was a factor. OUR TIGER was slow early and never menaced. J. MAX showed little. WINTER TEMPTATION failed to menace.
