KING OF RHYTHM stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and just got up under strong encouragement. BEGG'S stalked the pace, raced three wide in the stretch and finished gamely to just miss. THREE RUDYS set all the pace along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. KANWIN SO MUCH pressed the pace along the inside and weakened. CHAMP KAMAL reared at the start, lost a considerable amount of ground, raced four wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. I THINK IT IS failed to sustain a bid. HALO'S ROCKET saved ground and never menaced. SAX NOTES dropped back early, raced five wide throughout and never threatened.
