KING TYMATT rallied inside through the turn to challenge turning for home then kept CLUEMASTER safe late under steady urging. CLUEMASTER rallied four and five wide through the turn into the lane and slowly closed but could not run down the winner. ANEJO showed the most early speed racing from the three path then could not handle the top pair late. DR. SEVENCOMELEVEN was just off the leader early while three to four wide and had no closing bid. SELECTED lacked a rally racing three wide. BURN CARD saved ground and weakened. FAREWELL BROADWAY dwelt at the start to spot the field several lengths then moved up late from the inside. RICK'S WONDERBOY was not a factor racing four wide. LAMBADA was no threat while five wide in the turn. VALID INVADER was outrun racing four and five wide.
