KENTUCKY MILE was slow early, saved ground throughout and finished gamely to be well clear under a vigorous hand ride. MINER BIRD stalked the pace, raced three deep and was no match for the winner. GEOCACHE showed good speed from the inside and weakened. SPOKEN IN TONES saved ground and never menaced. BEAN was allowed to settle early, raced four wide and never was a factor. YES IT'S HOT stalked the pace and tired. I THINK IT IS showed good speed and tired readily in the final stages.
