FIRST CLASS BRASS tracked the leaders while saving ground to late backstretch, bid between rivals into the far turn to move well clear then held safe under steady handling. ANOTHER DIAMOND forced the pace from outside SALT LAKE UTAH to late backstretch, could not go with the winner but held well to keep position late. SALT LAKE UTAH moved clear in the opening quarter from along the inside then could not produce the needed late response. TOGA CAT tracked the leaders from three or four wide and lacked the needed late effort. MAYWOOD'S Z moved up four and five wide but could not threaten the top ones. DEJA BOUTI saved ground and lacked a closing bid. FARVE stalked the pace from four wide and weakened. WEST MEADOWLAKE steadied into the first turn then lacked a rally racing three wide. BROCKHILL was always back. WAGER ALL was four and five wide through the first turn and tired.
