Footnotes

BLUFF CENTER ROAD stalked the early leaders while four and five wide, bid outside NAMARKALIE in late backstretch then dueled that one the remainder and was slowly moving clear late. NAMARKALIE was just off the early lead then moved with the winner in late backstretch, dueled the remainder then had her rider lose whip inside the sixteenth marker and could not go with the winner late. QUIRK'S Q T moved up three and four wide to be within reach of the pace going to the far turn but could not go with the top pair in the final quarter mile. MAGIC PLAYER was bumped at the start, saved ground and improved position while not a threat. SLUPER moved up three and four wide while not a threat. DIAMONDSFORAYBRIE saved ground in reach of the pace for a half mile and weakened. SCATALAC moved to a clear lead racing about the three path through the first turn and tired. FANCY RANSOM came in and bumped with a rival at the break then was always back while saving ground. EVERETTI hesitated at the break and was tired racing four to five wide.
