JUST HANK vied from outside rivals to be four wide into the lane, dug in through the lane and prevailed late in a good effort. GIN HE KIN HE vied from inside rivals through the turn then held well in the lane to narrowly miss. GOLD SOLDIER rallied five wide into the lane with his bid then could not run down the top ones late. MINIMAL RISK vied from between rivals on the lead through the turn then lacked the needed final response in the drive. GRANT TOWN BLUES steadied a bit racing up the backstretch and angled three wide as a rival drifted in, remained in reach but could not produce the needed late run. PAWNEE RAIDER was not a threat racing three wide. THUNDERING SARACCO drifted in heading up the backstretch, remained along the inside and weakened. SNEAKIE PETESKI saved ground and was not a factor. HARRYANDARTSGHAZI steadied shortly after the break to shuffle back and was outrun.
