### Footnotes

LIGHT SWEET CRUDE set all the pace from the inside and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. FAST CITY GIRL stalked the pace along the inside, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. DIALECT pressed the pace, raced three wide and weakened a bit in the final stages. SECRET'S RIFLE was allowed to settle early, saved ground throughout, moved up through the far turn and had no final winning bid. CONSUMERS YUZUMER was slow early, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. MONEY TAK showed little. NAYBORHOOD AFFAIR raced four wide and never was a factor. HALF MOON LADY stalked the pace and tired.
