THREE LEGGED GRAVY settled back off the pace racing four wide while unhurried, launched her rally going to the far turn to rally four and five wide, sustained the run into the lane to collar the leaders and quickly drew off under steady handling. STEVIE'S SQUEEZE stalked the pace racing three wide, angled in going to the far turn, rallied up the rail in the lane and moved clear for the place while not a match for the winner. JALAL sprinted off to a commanding lead in the opening furlong, carried a clear lead to upper stretch and had little left. KISSEDBYABUTTERFLY settled back off the pace racing three and four wide and lacked a closing response. PROPER QUICK stumbled to her nose at the break, dropped far back off the pace and made a late run while three to four wide. ZINUS saved ground and tired. LUCKY S K chased the leaders racing two to three wide and tired. DEE MARTHA was always outrun.
