Footnotes

SHADOWBDANCING shadowed the pace while patiently handled for a half mile, ranged up outside the leaders heading up the backstretch to challenge into the far turn, continued from outside REACH ONE MORE through that bend then drew clear late under intermittent urging. REACH ONE MORE moved up outside ROARING HOME to prompt the pace from three wide, continued with that one midway up the backstretch then continued with the winner through the far turn but could not match strides in the final furlong. NO WALKIN' JOE saved ground while at the back of the field, moved up through the far turn while angling out to move four wide into the lane then could not get to the top pair while moving clear for his position. PLATINUM DEVIL settled back off the pace racing outside, rallied four and five wide through the far turn into the lane and improved his position but could not threaten in the drive. ROARING HOME made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail, remained a prominent factor to the far turn and had little left nearing the lane. CALM AND COLLECTED settled back racing four wide and failed to produce a solid bid. THE NUTZ stalked the leaders racing three to four wide in good position but tired through the far turn.
