HESO set all the pace and prevailed in the drive under all out pressure. SEASIDE LINKS stalked the pace, was fanned seven wide into the upper stretch and gained ground gamely in the final stages to just miss. BAD BOY AIDAN pressed the pace while racing between rivals and weakened a bit in the drive. POWER SWEEP LEFT stalked the pace, raced four deep and lacked a final response in the drive. MR. PINSTRIPE was bumped at the start, raced five deep in the lane and never was a real threat. SKWHIRL was slow early, raced nine wide into the upper stretch and never menaced. I SPY WOLFIE failed to sustain a bid. COLOMBIANO stalked the pace and tired. THE BATISTA BOMB was fractious in the gate, raced three deep and never menaced.
