DUNCAN MISS pressed the pace, raced three wide and finished second best. SELECTIVE SECURITY raced four wide and made a mild late rally in the lane. MOONLIGHT FLYER raced five wide and never threatened. SURRY'S PROSPECT failed to respond. LITTLE CENT failed to respond. MISS TWO BAGGER failed to menace. SAXMAN PROSPECT was hustled along and tired. FUZZY NAEVUS stalked the pace, raced wide early and tired. DANCE O WAR showed little.
