Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. High Weights Preferred (On the scale). Total earnings in 2007-08 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 10 starters. Closed Wednesday, April 16 with thirty two nominations.

THE NUTZ settled back off the early leaders while out from the rail, moved four wide to challenge outside YIELD TO THE STORM going to the far turn, moved clear into the stretch then went gamely late as WAYZATA BAY made his late run. WAYZATA BAY lingered at the back of the field while unhurried and out from the rail for a half mile, began moving out and launched his rally five wide into the far turn, fanned seven wide into the lane and closed with a rush but could not reach the winner. HABANEROS stalked the pace from outside, moved out to rally five wide through the far turn and closed in the lane but could not get to the top pair. YIELD TO THE STORM moved clear early and established a good pace racing out from the rail, resisted the winner briefly through the far turn but could not match strides approaching the stretch then weakened to lose position late. FIRST CLASS BRASS moved up outside to make a mild bid five wide going to the final turn and weakened. PERSEPOLIS chased the pace of THE NUTZ racing out in the three to four path and weakened. BLUMIN ATTITUDE stalked the pace racing out from the rail, moved inside rivals in late backstretch with his bid and tired. HOT CHOCOLATE saved ground and failed to mount a convincing bid. OKIE DOZER bobbed slightly at the start, chased the pace while widest throughout and gave way then was eased through the far turn.
