TAKE SOME ADVICE showed good early speed to move clear and gain the inside, drew off through the turn and widened under steady urging. FIVE MILE followed the pace from between rivals in the turn and edged clear for the place while no threat to the winner. BUDS CHOPIN WOOD was with the leaders early while three or four wide and had no closing bid. SAM DIEGO chased the pace from along the inside and weakened. GAZY GUS saved ground and was not a threat. AY DIOS MIO bobbed at the break and was not a threat while saving ground. SAVE THE FARM was outrun racing three wide.
